This generalized map was updated by Arctic Slope Regional Corporation (ASRC) on 4/10/2010. The official source for current land status resides with the U.S. Bureau of Land Management. Commercial operators must have a permit from the North Slope Borough to use this area.

Upstream of Umiat ASRC owns the uplands, islands, and riverbed of the Colville River up to the NPR-A boundary where ASRC has ownership.

The State of Alaska owns the riverbed of the Colville River downstream of Umiat. ASRC owns uplands and islands outside of NPR-A downstream of Umiat along the Colville River to just past the Anaktuvuk River.

**Colville River Recreational Easement Upstream of Umiat:**  
 A recreational easement on and over the bed of the Colville River, including islands, a linear stream-side easement on any lands owned by ASRC between the ordinary high water mark and the highest high water mark on the left (looking downstream) or west bank of the Colville River, and a linear stream-side easement over a strip of land running parallel to, and extending 50 feet upland from, the ordinary high water mark on the east or right bank (looking downstream) of the Colville River for recreational purposes, including, without limitation, boating, fishing and camping, but expressly excluding hunting.
