





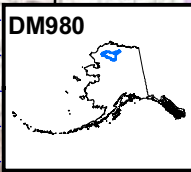
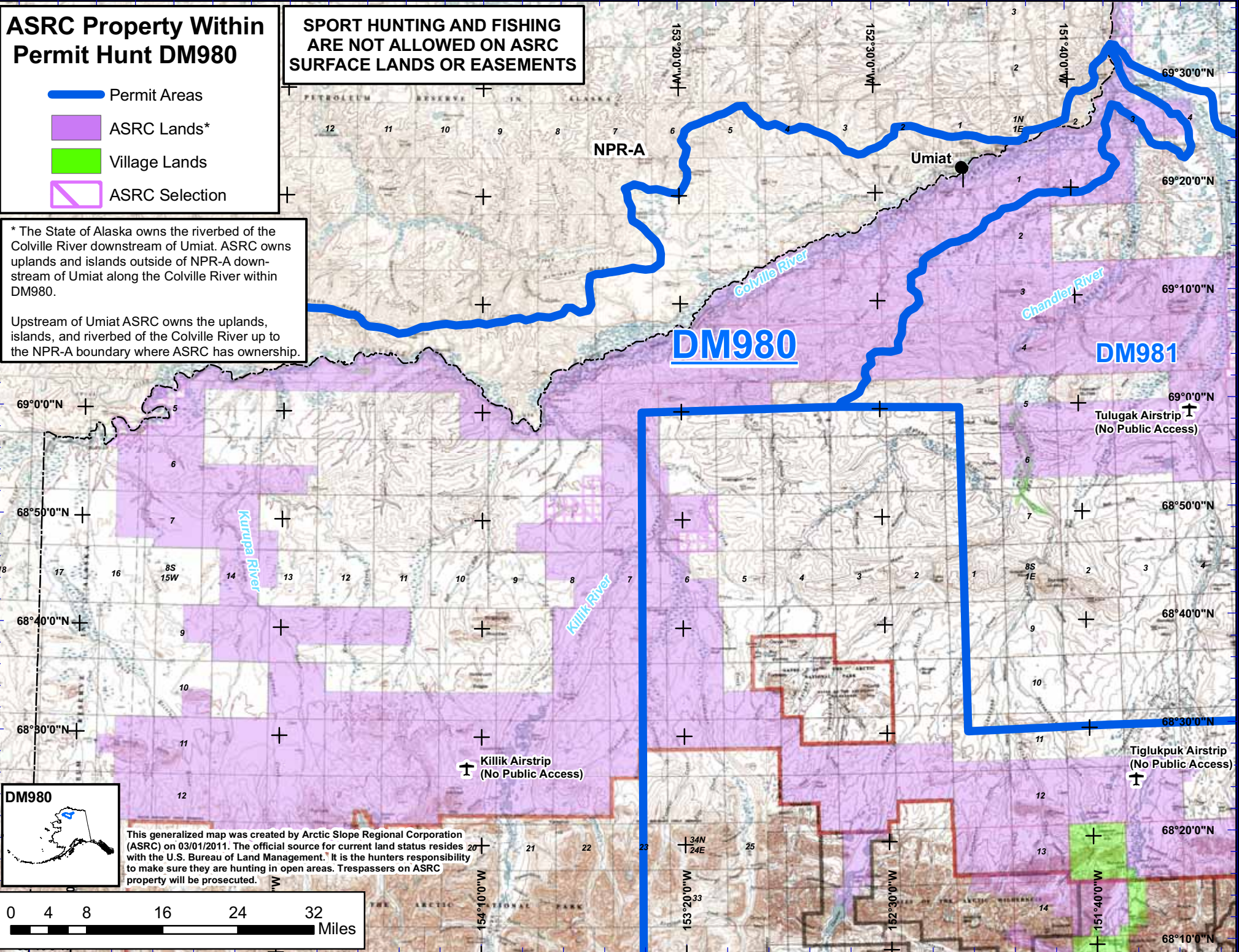
ASRC Property Within Permit Hunt DM980

* The State of Alaska owns the riverbed of the Colville River downstream of Umiat. ASRC owns uplands and islands outside of NPR-A downstream of Umiat along the Colville River within DM980.

Upstream of Umiat ASRC owns the uplands, islands, and riverbed of the Colville River up to the NPR-A boundary where ASRC has ownership.
